Community Partners Working Together!

Through our work with local partners, we are building and supporting collaborations to provide long-term social changes and economic growth in Wilson. The partnerships and collaborations formed by well-designed initiatives are helping our community utilize existing resources while strengthening our ability to secure additional resources through grants and other funding agencies. Our work is designed to discourage duplication of efforts while aligning and leveraging the efforts, advantages, skills, passion, and expertise of our community partners.

Youth Master Plan – A Community Plan to Support Our Youth

With more than 125 community partners focusing on common goals and objectives to improve the outcomes for all youth in Wilson, the **Youth Master Plan (YMP)** represented our first model of cross-sector collaboration. The **YMP** was led by a partnership of *Wilson Forward* and Wilson County Schools with a specific focus on safety, wellness, education, workforce development, and out of school time. The goals and actions identified in this plan are having a significant impact today!

Beyond 21 Plan – A Community Plan to Attract, Retain, and Support our Adult Population

With more than 75 community partners, we are in our final phase of implementation for the **Beyond 21 Plan** designed to meet the needs of our adult community. This Plan represents the collaborative efforts of all participating partners to address local unemployment, talent attraction and retention, the growing needs of an aging population, strengthening community leadership and civic engagement, and improving our community's health.

The Impact Initiative – A Leadership Program in Wilson and For Wilson

Wilson Forward partnered with the Wilson Chamber of Commerce and the Wilson Economic Development Council to offer The Impact Initiative, a leadership development program to build a pipeline of leadership for our local community. The Impact Initiative is designed to identify, train, and deploy individuals with an interest in representative leadership positions in and for Wilson. The second cohort of participants will graduate in 2019.

Service Year NC - In 2017, Wilson was one of four communities selected through a competitive statewide application process to participate in the **Institute of Emerging Issues (IEI) Service Year NC initiative.** In partnership with United Way, Barton College, City of Wilson, Wilson County Health Department, Wilson YMCA, and Healthcare Foundation of Wilson, we now host 5 Vistas who are building greater capacity for several health and wellness programs in Wilson, NC.

InnovateNC - To ensure our state's future competitiveness and economic prosperity, Wilson joined 4 other communities in NC to participate in **IEI's InnovateNC** initiative, an intensive effort to encourage innovation capacity growth and expand local economies in NC. In partnership with the City of Wilson, *Wilson Forward* is connecting local organizations and leadership from all sectors to create sustainable economic growth in Wilson, NC.

The success of *Wilson Forward* is dependent on trust and clear communication from all parties. We are addressing complex challenges by working together, and our clear, concise communication is the foundation for effective partnerships and better results. Our common agendas align with the priorities established, and our work is designed to create strong relationships between all sectors of the community.

Our Board of Directors

Wilson Forward's Board of Directors consists of 13 ex-officio leaders and 13 elected leaders selected from the Wilson community. The Board meets 6 times a year to review the progress of all ongoing initiatives and to address any immediate challenges or opportunities presented in the community. Our meetings are planned to provide a structured, yet open discussion for cross sector organizations to share ideas and suggestions for the community's growth.

Our Board of Advisors

Wilson Forward's Board of Advisors (BOA) consists of approximately 50 community members and leaders who serve in various roles representing many sectors of our community. The BOA provides guidance and necessary feedback to assist in the direction of our Board of Directors.

Continuing Growth and Outreach

Over the course of the past several years, we have established one-time working groups as well as recurring discussion groups to address specific topics and areas of local concern and opportunity. We have hosted numerous sessions with health and wellness partners, workforce development partners, diversity advocates and faith leaders. Our connections and communication with all sectors remain a priority, and as we move forward, we will continually evaluate opportunities for strategic and supportive conversations.
